SUNDAY 17th March 2024 FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT - Year B

Dear Parishioners, Friends and Visitors,

As human beings, we might be earthly, mortal, frail and broken creatures but we are fundamentally made to live beyond earthly life. 'Right from the beginning God has set eternity in the heart of every human person' (Ecclesiastes 3:11) and as a result, we can never be satisfied by the temporal. We long for a future life of unending love and joy—and with a King who will bring all our hopes to perfect realisation.



This is why we cannot be content with the present world of injustice, pain and suffering. Eternal, true and lasting joy comes in anticipating, and living in the light of our future life with our God, who made us for Himself. Saint Augustine aptly captured this when he said: "Thou hast made us for Thyself O God, and the heart of man is restless until it finds its rest in Thee." In another place, he also said that, 'the whole life of a good Christian is a holy desire to live with God in eternity.'

In the gospel this weekend, the Greeks who approached Philip with an ardent request 'to see Jesus' were craving after the deepest longing of the human heart, and the ultimate desire of the human soul. The expression 'to see Jesus' does not just mean an attempt to have a physical guess at Jesus or an ordinary glance at the person of Jesus Christ. It was more than that. They were after an intimate, deep and personal encounter with the person of Jesus Christ. In his book 'Mere Christian,' C.S. Lewis, wrote: "I must keep alive in myself the desire for my true country, which I shall not find till after death; I must never let it get snowed under or turned aside; I must make it the main object of life to press on to that other country and to help others to do the same."

The ache in every human heart is an ache to see God face to face when we are done and dusted with this mortal life. Therefore, 'there is within every human person a God-shaped vacuum, an emptiness that only God can fill,' said a one-time French Philosopher and Catholic Theologian Blaise Pascal. The Greek pilgrims were not in Jerusalem for a fanfare, but on a journey of encounter. It was a spiritual journey for them, since there was in each of them 'a God-shaped vacuum, an emptiness that only God can fill.'

Since Ash Wednesday, we have been on the same journey of encounter with the person of Jesus Christ. In these Lenten days, we have been contemplating while at the same time making efforts to imitate Christ's life, passion, death and resurrection. In fact, the whole point of our Lenten journey has been to lead us to the heart of who Jesus Christ is, and what Christ has done for us. John the Evangelist did not reveal what happened to the Greeks who wanted to 'see Jesus.' However, the Evangelist rather reported what appeared to have been the response of Christ to them: "unless a wheat grain falls on the ground and dies, it remains only a single grain; but if it dies, it yields a rich harvest. Anyone who loves his or her life loses it; anyone who hates his or her life in this world, will keep it for the eternal life." (John 12:24-25)

This is one of the central truths of human life and this truth is also at the heart of the Christian faith. The ultimate desire of every human soul which is to see God face to face at the end of this mortal life, will be impossible without some sort of *kenosis* - self emptying. Therefore, let's not allow fear of the unknown to deprive us of what is not just the ultimate desire of the human soul but also the one and only ultimate longing of the human heart. Saint Augustine had an undying longing for a life with God when he said: "all my empty dreams suddenly lost their charm and (Contd. P2)

VERSE FOR VINNIES




